2009 TAVISTOCK CUP ANNOUNCES TEAM CAPTAINS

ORLANDO, Fla. (February 16, 2009) – Team Captains Mark O'Meara and Ernie Els will once again lead a roster of golf stars from Isleworth Golf & Country Club and Lake Nona Golf & Country Club into the 2009 Tavistock Cup.

Celebrating its sixth year, the Tavistock Cup is a unique interclub competition pitting the golf professional members of Isleworth against their counterparts at Lake Nona. The officially sanctioned PGA Tour event takes place at Lake Nona Golf & Country Club March 16-17.

The tournament's past participants have featured golf's biggest names, including O'Meara, Els, Stuart Appleby, Darren Clarke, Paula Creamer, Sergio Garcia, Trevor Immelman, Ian Poulter, Justin Rose, Annika Sorenstam and Tiger Woods. Complete team rosters for this year's tournament will be released in March.

Team Isleworth claimed the inaugural Tavistock Cup in 2004 at Lake Nona Golf & Country Club. Isleworth hosted the Tavistock Cup matches for the next two years. Following a sudden-death playoff that resulted in a tie in 2005, Team Isleworth was victorious again in 2006. Team Lake Nona's home course advantage helped clinch its first Tavistock Cup victory in 2007. Last year, Tavistock Cup rookie J.B. Holmes helped lead Team Isleworth to its third victory.

To date, the golf professional members of Isleworth and Lake Nona have won a combined total of 53 major championships and more than 710 victories worldwide.

Over the past five years, the tournament has donated millions of dollars to many worthy organizations around the globe including M. D. Anderson Cancer Center Orlando, The First Tee and the University of Central Florida Foundation. In 2009, the Tavistock Cup through the Tavistock Foundation will once again donate \$1 million on behalf of the players on the winning team to the charities of their choice.

With its no ropes structure and invitation-only gallery, the Tavistock Cup has emerged as one of the most sought-after spectator events in professional sports. In the spirit of Tavistock Cup

competition, spectators wear the official team colors of Isleworth Red or Lake Nona Blue to show their support for Team Isleworth or Team Lake Nona.

“This invitation-only event for members, residents, sponsors and invited guests is truly unlike anything in the game of golf,” said Andy Odenbach, vice president of sports ventures for Tavistock Group. “We try to create the most relaxed environment possible for both spectators and players alike, but more importantly, we are helping many organizations around the globe through our charitable initiatives.”

The Tavistock Cup will be televised live on the Golf Channel in the U.S., Canada and Japan and to more than 40 countries around the world through international affiliates. TavistockCup.com will also feature real-time live scoring of the matches.
